

**Amendment to Article V Committees:**

**Section 1.0 Members** Special Committees, established by the commission will be comprised of an odd number of voting committee members; 2 members shall be commissioners in good standing. The remaining three positions are to be filled by qualified volunteers. Each commissioner will serve a one year term and may continue to serve on the committee as long as they are a commissioner in good standing; the volunteers with voting rights will serve a one year term from the calendar date of appointment.

This amendment also states a special committee shall designate one of the two commissioners as chairman of the committee and he/she shall not serve more than one, one-year term.

**Section 2.0 Eligibility** Volunteers will be required to apply for the voting position on special committees (see Application for Volunteer following). Volunteers will only be allowed voting rights on one special committee per year. These applications will then be submitted to the commission for review. The commission will review applicants qualifications for service prior to voting for an applicant's appointment as a voting member of a special committee. If approved by the commission by a simple majority vote at the general commission meeting to adopt a motion for appointment, specified volunteers will have a voting right regarding business conducted by the special committee for which they have applied.

**Section 3.0 Expiration and Vacancy** This amendment states that upon the expiration of the term of any voting volunteer member, that seat shall remain vacant until a volunteer applies under the terms of Section 2.0 Eligibility above and is confirmed by the commission.

With the expiration of the term of a commissioner, said commissioner also forfeits his or her voting rights regarding business conducted for any special committees on which they served. That seat shall remain vacant until a commissioner volunteers to fill that seat.

**Section 4.0 Meetings** All meetings for special committees shall be run in accordance with Article IV of the Wicker Park and Bucktown Special Service Area #33 Bylaws. Note under Section 4.0 Attendance that volunteers with voting rights serve under the same conditions as commissioners regarding absenteeism.
