

TRANSPORTATION: PEDESTRIANS AND PASSENGERS COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES

The Committee met on January 21, 2010 from 8:30-9:30 at the Center for Neighborhood Technology

- I. The Committee discussed assessing the success of the bustracker pilot program with input from surveys. The surveys are to be completed by (a) shop owners hosting bustracker displays and (b) users of the bustracker displays. The Committee discussed finalizing the content of the surveys and when to administer the surveys.
- II. The Committee discussed progress on the recommendations contained in the Master Plan. A revised status report on such progress is being submitted to the SSA Program Director along with these Minutes.
- III. The Committee also discussed proposals for Project of the Year. Our proposals are recommendations 7.1 (creating pedestrian gateways) and 7.3 (reclaiming pedestrian space and slowing traffic with bump-outs, striping, and by removing excess asphalt).
- IV. The Committee discussed mural projects for development sites and the potential locations for the You Are Beautiful mural. The Committee will continue to consider a location.
- V. The Committee continued to discuss the sidewalk inventory and the information to be sought in connection with the project. The sidewalk inventory form will be revised to include a field for the location of (a) benches, (b) possible mural sites and (c) utility boxes.
- VI. The Committee discussed art installations at bus stops and requested more information prior to taking further action.
