- **Power Washing Polish Triangle**

- Committee approved Power Washing Systems to perform power washing duties at the Polish Triangle \$1,300 total (\$625 for triangle and \$675 for the surrounding sidewalks).

- MOTION: To fund power washing of the Polish Triangle in advance of the first Polish Triangle Marketplace series, by Power Washing Systems in the amount of \$1,300 from line 2.05 Sidewalk Cleaning.

- To be done before June 30

- Suggestion: In next WPB newsletter, have a section set aside to engage the community and encourage feedback (i.e. Tell Brian) Ask where people think the 3 worst offending areas are in the SSA that would benefit from power washing.

- **Painting Division Fences**

- Committee approved RFP from Cleanslate, motion to request funding for contract (\$21,000).

- MOTION: To fund the repainting of the Division Street fences in an amount not to exceed \$21,000 from line 2.02 Gate/Fence Maintenance. The work is to be completed by Cleanslate and this motion replaces all former Division Street Fence painting motions.

- Need to ask Cleanslate to be proactive and work with restaurant owners since their patio areas may be affected (customers and wet paint)

- **Bartlett Tree Update**

- Have inventoried approximately 1,500 trees in the SSA (additions have been made to the original count). Inventory list should be able to interface with futurity. (Bartlett information can be applied to any database).

- Eric working on list 1 priorities and will have report by next meeting

- Idea/Suggestion: Eric work with the Green Music Fest to showcase Integrated Pest Management (IPS). Possible PR with CGS/WPB
