

WPB Transportation (Ped-Pass-Pedal) Committee REPORT

The group met Wednesday, May 19, at 8:30 a.m. in our WPB office. In attendance were Adam, Ben, Brent, Eleanor, Joe, Nora Beck, Steven Vance, and Uri. The following topics were addressed:

1. Ben, Brent, and Eleanor reported on a meeting they had with the developers of a hi-tech parking facility on Milwaukee Ave, Green Park. There didn't seem to be any reason to reconsider the committee's original rejection of their request to fund a shuttle bus to support their development.

2. Our committee is co-sponsoring a rest stop during Bike to Work Week at the Polish Triangle. On Wednesday, June 16, starting at 6:30a.m. We will be handing out branded leg bands to bicycle commuters. Volunteers welcome.

3. Bus Tracker: As part of his neighborhood canvas, Uri will be promoting and evaluating the system, including the guerrilla installations.

4. Ben encouraged Uri to think in terms of "Pedestrian Potential" while doing his sidewalk survey.

5. The sites for the installation of our new bike racks will be chosen from existing requests as well as general observations by staff and committee members. We have received a quote from CDOT for installation of all 20 racks.

Motion: *To fund \$3,500 from line 6.01 Bike Advocacy to cover the cost of CDOT's installation of the 20 orange supplemental sidewalk "WPB Rides" bike racks throughout WPB.*

6. The installation of the "On Street" bike is close at hand, but probably not next week.
