1. The Arts Guide Book---

---A preliminary draft of the Arts Guide Book was presented.

---The lists of artistic entities were reviewed and categories were defined and the guide book will be labeled 2011-2012

---Quotes from neighborhood arts notables were requested. Annette will collect this information.

2. The Mural Project

---We will work on installation of “orange place markers” once sites have been pinned down. Anna and Whitney will work with an intern to hasten this process. We are targeting 14 days for site approval.

---We hope to release the RFP for artists on July 15.

3. “Out of Site” a performance series

4. Adopt A Station

---The committee voted to fund the additional \$2500 needed to get this project underway. \$2500 in matching funds would come from the Promote Committee.
