

**TRANSPORTATION: BICYCLES, PEDESTRIANS AND PASSENGERS**  
**COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

The Committee met on July 21 from 8:30-9:30 at the WPB Chamber office.

Members Present: *Co-Chair Joe Hall; Co-Chair Brent Norsman; Eleanor Mayer, Steven Vance, Jessica Wobbekind, Elaine Coorens, Julia Kim (Rep. from Active Transportation Alliance)*

- I. On-Street Bike Parking
  - a. Install scheduled for Friday July 29<sup>th</sup>, ribbon cutting with alderman and DOT administrator
  - b. After party at Francesco Forno's
  - c. Give away raffle, WPB to post a map and push pins for attendees to suggest bike rack locations.
  
- II. WPB Rides Bike Racks
  - a. JW completed a first street inventory with potential locations for remaining racks to be installed.
  - b. Committee member suggested additional locations.
  - c. WPB to schedule walk through of potential locations with DOT reps.
  - d. Install to occur likely in August.
  
- III. Milwaukee/ Wood/ Intersection Status
  - a. Meeting scheduled with Alderman and DOT reps to discuss status.  
*Meeting has since occurred Aug. 26 and DOT confirmed that they think the curb extension and re-design may occur within the original budget allocated by WPB and Alderman's office. This will not include landscape and streetscape furnishings.*
  
- IV. Like Bike Ride Presentation by Elaine Coorens
  - a. EC presented event planned for Sept. 18 including a ride up Milwaukee Avenue. They are looking for support financially from WPB –T. The committee requested additional information including budgets prior to consideration.
  
- V. Neighborhood "Open-Streets" day- Active Transportation presentation
  - a. Julia Kim, a representative from Active Transportation Alliance, presented their future plans for Open Streets dates and activities. The next event is planned for Sept. 9 and will occur on State Street between Lake St. and Van Buren.
  - b. WPB expressed interest in future Open Streets events in our district and suggested 3 events for next year on Milwaukee Avenue suggesting repetition of the events will build attendance and awareness.
