- I. Bike Parking: WPB Rides Bike Racks have been a big success
 - a. Discussion if more should be installed this year
 - b. Should this be an on-going program like façade rebate, graffiti abatement?
 - c. JW will look into costs of additional racks and create bike parking price spreadsheet.
 - d. Contact Chris Gagnon about possible barriers to further protect the on-street bike parking.

- II. On-Street Cafes and “Park-lets”
 - a. The city is looking for pilots, WPB would like to be the first
 - b. Someone from the city had talked to AB about something like this, he will try to find the contact and get more info.

- III. Milwaukee/ Wood/ Intersection Status
 - a. JW will contact the other committees to find out if they would like to contribute to the POY.
 - b. Possible ideas: public art, bike infrastructure, way-finding kiosk, find out if Walgreens can landscape their parking lot to match the new landscaping.

- IV. Other city transportation news:
 - a. There is going to be an RFP released for bike sharing, we should keep this in mind for WPB.
 - b. Open Streets on State Street, Oct. 7. WPB should try to do this on Milwaukee next year.
